This membership allows you to attend any or all meetings at the discounted member rate. Annual membership dues are \$100. Monthly meeting dues are \$20.

All inclusive Membership:

This membership allows you to attend all meetings at no cost and provides an easier solution for you if your company is sponsoring memberships. Annual membership dues are \$260.

All inclusive Corporate Memberships*:

This allows your company to purchase memberships without named members and offer it to your women employees. Meetings will be at no charge.
